

MapQuest to Garmin Routes

NOTE: This only works for **MapQuest** and **Garmin GPS** which supports **Custom Routes**.

NOTE 2: The first time you plug in your Garmin, it will ask you to download the Garmin Installer.

In MapQuest (You **MUST** use www.mapquest.com it will not work with mapquest.ca)

This link will take you there: <http://www.mapquest.com/maps?country=CA>

- Type in start address in field at left
- Right click on next stop/town/address and choose Directions
- Continue to add points - route may be changed by dragging route (but see note below)
- **NOTE:** modified routes don't show up, so can't modify and send to Garmin

When Route is completed

- Connect Garmin to computer (it will turn itself on) wait until it is connected
- Click on **Send** near top right of map on MapQuest
- Choose **Garmin GPS**
- Under Select Device(s) check off the Nuvi model
- Click **Send** button - the Success window will come up
- **NOTE:** You can rename the file before sending it to the Garmin
- Now disconnect the Garmin from your computer

Getting the route to show up in the Garmin

- Power up your Garmin
- Go to **Tools**
- Go to **My Data** folder
- Choose **Import Route(s)**
- It will be listed as **MapQuest-XXX** (some 3 digit number)
If you renamed the file before sending (eg. BRBS2012) then look for that file
- Click on the file
- Click **Import**
- Click **OK** when data shows successfully imported
- You will then find **MapQuest-XXX (Or the name you gave it)** listed in the **Routes** folder
- At this point you can click on it to see the route and can edit the name

Using a custom route

- Click **Where To?**
- Go to the **Routes** folder
- Select the route you wish to take
- Select **View Map**
- Click **Go**
